Jesus Speaks to Evil

- Maybe you've seen a lot of evil in your life. Maybe not.
- Maybe you've wondered about evil.
 - o Isn't it a problem? God is love? And evil exists? How? Honest Question.
- Maybe like friends in America, "Wow, Cambodia is so dark. So evil."
 - o Perhaps they didn't work downtown in the ER with me
 - Didn't see the looks of desperation on the druggies face
 - Not that they were evil, but a result of evil
 - The panic in the woman's eyes who'd just been abused
 - The sheer violence of another gang-related murder.
 - Hospital on lock down, prevent the other bad guys!
 - o Perhaps they didn't know the guy with the Hebrew on his forehead...
 - In pod S, "you seem very spiritual."

- “I can see the aura around you is very thick and bright.”
- Maybe they didn’t walk around the Psychics Convention
 - See the fortune tellers, the conjurers
 - Free entry, and I wanted to pray over the folks as they lined up to channel a dead friend or relative. Kind of spooky.
- Not going to “solve” the problem with evil, or answer the questions
 - BUT, we are going to look at what Jesus said in one instance
 - Face to face with Evil, with Father of Lies and Enemy Number One
 - Face to face with Satan, when Satan tried his best. AND FAILED.
 - Perhaps, this encounter can change the way we think.

Why I’m Sharing this

- Feel like a beggar who’s found some bread
- In Cambodia almost two years
 - Hard, but good
 - See evil, unfairness, women treated like trash
 - Full of doubt.
 - Full of fear
 - Full of temptation
 - (Maybe ya’ll never have those “down” times, but whatev. I do.
- Feel like Evil has often spoken to me, in those dark places. RASPY VOICE.
 - What can you do?
 - Why are you here?
 - What about your kids?
 - This is stupid.
 - You’re not equipped, not trained,
 - You’re not like them (other smart, missionaries with Bible degrees)
- This verse, written on my office wall, has been to me a rock.
 - It has been to me a solid handhold during this mountain climb.
 - And when I couldn’t hold on any longer, it has been the rope that caught me.
- When I feel like Theodin, saying in the bowels of Helms Deep, at the end of hope,
 - **“So much death. What can men do in the face of such reckless hate.”** This verse has been to me like

- Aragorn, saying, ***“Ride out with me. Ride out and meet them.”***

Jesus Speaks

- Recap Story **Matthew 4** – temptation of Jesus
 - Jesus is tired and hungry, potentially at weakest point.
 - Lonely? Been by himself the whole time.
 - NOT a cozy, chat over coffee!
 - Prince of Evil vs. Prince of Peace
 - These two are NOT friends.
 - NOT a friendly bargaining process like at Russian Market
 - War.
- Satan will not leave.
 - Satan keeps talking and stalking.

“You want food, right? Nice, fresh-baked bread? How long has it been, Jesus? Eat.” “How about you prove God cares for you? I don’t think he does. Jump.” “OK, everyone wants stuff, power, and control. You want some? I’ll give it all to you. Bow.”
- We sometimes think Jesus coolly replies, “Oh, you silly Satan, you know the Bible says...”
 - But this was a battle.
 - This temptation was real.
 - *Jesus felt this.*
- I believe Jesus looks straight into his ugly, evil eyes, and says,
 - IT IS WRITTEN. YOU MUST WORSHIP THE LORD YOUR GOD. SERVE ONLY HIM.
- And Satan left. Amazing.
- What does Jesus speak to EVIL?

I will worship the Lord my God. I will serve only him.

- Jesus wasn't just saying, “Hey, the Bible Says.”
 - He was stating, with certainty and all the power he could muster,
 - I WILL WORSHIP THE LORD MY GOD. I WILL SERVE ONLY HIM
 - **Maybe you need to start saying this.**
 - He was emphatically stating
 - I will NOT listen to you, Satan.

- I will worship only One, and you're not it.
- I will NOT follow you.
- I will NOT obey you.
- I will NEVER bow to you.
- Go back to hell where you belong.
- I'm with Him!

- Perhaps this is too simplistic, but I've tested this, and I've prayed this hundreds of times this year.
 - **When I could pray little else**, I've simply stuttered,
 - "I will worship the Lord my God. I will serve only Him."
 - I've prayed it silently, I've prayed it out loud.
 - **When I've been discouraged**, I've asked God to help me do it.
 - "God, help me worship you. Help me serve only you."
 - **When I've felt tempted**, I've said this out loud, so Satan and his demons could here. I'm with Jesus on this one.
- Listen to what Jesus says to Evil, and let it change the way you think.
- LET THIS BE YOUR PRAYER TOO!

About Temptation

- Something a few of you might wrestle with. :)
- Seriously, I'm not just talking about temptation to commit the Big Sins, whatever you think those are.
 - Maybe it's temptation to sin. Like a real, no doubt about it sin.
 - But maybe it's a temptation to despair?
 - To doubt?
 - To leave God because of pain. You've been hurt too deeply.
- Want to give you a very practical tool.
- First – Have to know...
 - You gotta know Satan smarter than you. (you don't "got this")
 - He's stronger,
 - He's got more wit,
 - More charm,
 - More experience.
 - He has more time,

- More resources.
- You can't argue with Satan and win.
- You can't outlast him, outsmart him, or outcast him.
 - ***But you can resist him. And you must.***

Here's How – Use Jesus' Tool

- The Truth: There is only One God. I'm serving him.
- This is your stake in the ground,
 - The peg (however you define peg) to hang your hat on,
 - The point to hang your life on.
 - I will worship the Lord my God. I will serve only him.
- In saying this, you steal Satan's thunder
 - You take the bullet out of his gun
 - Crack the wings off his plane
 - Pull the tracks off his tank
 - You draw a big thick line in the sand.
 - You remind Satan and yourself that you worship One, and that it's not him.
- Furthermore, You remind yourself.
 - And you remind God.
 - I believe God hears this statement and responds. (been my experience)

What was Satan's Response?

- Satan responds.....by leaving.
- And God responds by sending angels to minister to Jesus.
- Put another way, SATAN RESPONDS BY LEAVING, AND GOD RESPONDS BY COMING. HE SHOWS UP. And that's a pretty good trade, I think.

May God transform our minds by changing the way we think.

- Yes, there is pain, yes there is Evil, but there is God.
- Yes there is temptation, yes there is discouragement and doubt, but there is God.
- And I've decided that with everything in me, until my last breath, I will worship the Lord **MY** God. I will serve only Him.

- I hope you'll join me.
